

2010 OKTOBERFEST RIDE TICKET BRACELET INFORMATION-

\$13 Ride bracelets must be purchased by Wed. noon at City Hall

Many are interested in purchasing the bracelets for rides that are provided by the Oktoberfest for their annual Carnival.

Coupons for the bracelets are available at City Hall, 309 N. Chestnut Street, from 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. each weekday until Wednesday noon, September 30th, 2009.

Cost of the bracelets is \$13, for three days of all-you-can-ride. Coupons are to be taken to the carnival office to be exchanged for the bracelet. Armband cannot be removed during the three-day period. The carnival opens on Sept. 30 - Wednesday evening at 5:00 p.m. (a day before the Oktoberfest actually starts), and the bracelets are good for Wednesday, Sept. 29, 5:00 p.m. – close, Thursday, Sept. 30 from 1:00 p.m. - close, and Friday, Oct. 1, from 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Persons who wish to mail in requests for the bracelet coupons may send a check for the total amount of coupons they wish to buy (\$13 per coupon) and a stamped, self-addressed envelope to: Jana Plump, City Hall, 309 N. Chestnut St., Seymour, IN 47274. Requests by mail must be postmarked by Thursday, Sept. 23, 2010.

Individual ride tickets will be sold at the carnival for \$2 each, or 10 for \$15. Each ride requires only one ticket.

One-day armbands may be purchased on Thursday or Friday only for \$17.
