

**RULES AND REGULATIONS  
OKTOBERFEST BAKING CONTEST  
THURSDAY, OCT. 4, 2007**

1. The contest is open to any Jackson County resident who is eighteen years of age or older. Professional bakers and employees of Larry E. Nunn and Associates are not eligible to participate. No fee is required.
2. Categories are:
  - A. Any pie: 1 or 2 homemade crusts, whole pie
  - B. Any cake: 1, 2 or 3 layers
3. All perishable foods must be kept on ice.
4. Entries may be box mixes, but must be exhibited on disposable dishes
5. A contestant may enter only one product in each category.
6. A contestant may win in only one category
7. Entry forms must be returned to Larry E. Nunn & Associates, or brought to City hall on the day of the contest along with the baked product.
8. Pies and cakes must be brought to Seymour's City Hall, 309 N. Chestnut, on Thursday, October 4, 2007, between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.
9. The recipe, including exact measurements, preparation steps and baking procedures for the total product must be typed/printed on a 3 x 5 card and attached to the exhibit. Entrant's name is not to appear on the recipe card.
10. Entries will be judged based on appearance, texture, flavor, and originality. The decision of the judges is final.
11. Prizes will be awarded for the pie and cake categories as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place \$100.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$50.00 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$25.00.
12. Winners will be announced Thursday, Oct. 4, 2007, at approximately 5:30 p.m. on the north stage of the corner of 3<sup>rd</sup> and Chestnut Streets.
13. All entries will become the property of Larry E. Nunn and Associates, Certified Public Accountants, L.L.C. and will be donated to a Charitable organization following the judging.
